HISTORICAL TOWNS IN WESTERN SLOVAKIA AND ARBORETUM IN MLYNANY

2 days / 1 night



Day 1 – City tour of **Bratislava** in the morning - a round tour by microbus passing the Grassalkovich Palace - today a seat of Slovak President up to castle hill with nice view to the Old Town as well as new parts of Bratislava. Walking tour will show you the Old Town with St. Michael's Gate, the first University Istropolitana, St. Martin's Cathedral - coronation church, the Primate's Palace, Main Square where the Old Town Hall and fountain of the knight Roland dominate and the tour finishes at the historical Opera House in Hviezdoslav Square and at nearby new renovated historical building of Slovak Philharmony. After short break we invite you to visit Devin Castle ruins

situated on a cliff above the confluence of Danube and Moravia Rivers. Dinner and overnight in Bratislava at a hotel 4*.

Day 2 – Departure from Bratislava to **Trnava** called "Slovak Rome" as it is a seat of Archbishop

- sightseeing tour of Trnava incl. entry to University church (St. John 's Cathedral). Tour continues to Nitra - one of the oldest towns in Slovakia - visit to Nitra Castle incl. of the Cathedrale of St. Emeram. The further stop is Mlyňany famous for its Arboretum with excursion. It falls under the administration of the Slovak



Academy of Sciences that manages the largest collection of non-native trees and shrubs in Slovakia,



which also happens to be one of the richest collections in Central Europe. The arboretum was founded in 1892 by Dr. Štefan Ambrózy-Migazzi, an aristocrat originally from Tana (now Tanakajd) in Hungary. Tour of the day ends in Zvolen.
