History:

- 1958 = Incorporated as the "American Institute of Wood Engineering"
- 1960 = Name changed to "Society of Wood Science and Technology". 1st Newsletter
- 1968 = 1st Issue of Wood & Fiber Science Journal
- 1976 = Critical Matters Committee Formed
- 1984 = Accreditation of undergraduate Wood Science and Technology Programs began



History (cont):

- 1986 = First George Marra Award for Excellence in Writing presented
- 1995 = Student Poster Competition initiated 27 students received awards to date
- <u>1996</u> = SWST Website
- 1999 = 1st Position Statement Approved
- 2001 = Teaching Units Introduced



History (cont):


- 2008 Electronic publishing of Wood and Fiber Science Journal






